

SMYRNA FIRST UNITED METHODIST PRESCHOOL/KINDERGARTEN

Smyrna First United Methodist Preschool/Kindergarten is a non-profit weekday school for children 2 years to 5 years old of any race, color, national, religious, or ethnic origin. The program, begun in 1969, is a ministry of Smyrna First United Methodist Church and is operated as a part of the church's educational program. It is administered by a Board of Directors.

We believe that our responsibility as a church-sponsored school is to provide a program that will foster development of the whole child: emotionally, intellectually, socially, physically, and spiritually.

The staff is composed of qualified and experienced early childhood educators. All of the staff are members of and are active in the Georgia Preschool Association and the school is certified as a School of Excellence by the North Georgia Preschool Association. All participate in a continuous program of in-service education in order to further their knowledge and to remain alert to the needs of our children.

All that we expect of the children in our school is that they come to school, be themselves, and have respect for others. Parents are expected to adhere to the operating procedures and rules of the school, meet their financial obligations in a timely manner, and support their child and his/her teachers.
